



Prices hit their peak

With the beginning of May comes a higher number at the pumps. Gas prices have increased to 107.9 in Regina and people are concerned they may go even higher.

However, according to En-Pro Gas Price Analyst Roger McKnight prices will actually drop a few cents in the next few days. He adds we should be thanking the Canadian dollar.

"Let's assume that crude was at what it is today and the Canadian dollar is what it was a year ago. That means the pump price in Regina would not be 107, it would be 118."

McKnight says the recent increase makes sense because the cost of crude is 40 per cent higher than it was last year.
